Rules / Format

Region 10 Board of Directors will be the managing committee for this series and will have final say in all decisions / disputes pertaining to this series via vote. Regional Rumble will consist of 5 legs. One leg at each Region 10 club and one leg at Good Times QMA. Each leg will coincide with the host clubs scheduled Memorial race.

All legs will be run in accordance with the host tracks club rules, procedures and bylaws unless otherwise noted in the Regional Rumble Rules / Format.

Five (5) sign-in points awarded at each leg. One mandatory throw-out. Sign-in points are not thrown out.

Format: 1 Round of Practice, Qualifying, Heat Race, Trophy Dash (Except Novice) & Mains

***Double Header Bonus!** Five (5) bonus points will be awarded to each driver for each class they run at both Leg # 2 and #3. Must run same class at both legs to be eligible for the bonus points.

All cars must run QMA Spec Dunlop tires on the right side.

Novice will **NOT** be a competitive class for this series.

Rookie of the Year for Junior and Senior will be awarded. Must run at least 1 leg as Novice. Winner will be determined by average points per competitive race (Series total points in competitive class divided by races run). **Must run 4 of 5 (3 of 5 competitive) races to be eligible for rookie of the year award.**

Must have at least 2 cars to constitute a class for 3 the 5 legs of the series

Driver Age Requirements – Junior Novice-Animal-Honda-Stock = 5 to 8, Senior Novice, Animal (Sr. & Hvy), Honda, Stock, "A", Mod WF, Lt. WF, Hvy WF = 9-17

Hvy Honda-Lt 160-Hvy 160-"B" = 8-17, Mod = 7-17, Half = 11-17.

DRIVER WHO AGES OUT OF A DIVISION MUST MOVE UP ON THEIR BIRTHDAY. NO EXCEPTIONS! Driver may run as underage with proper approval. Refer to QMA Rulebook Article 5, Section 1.1 (g) and Section 2.1(c)

Entry Fee of \$15 will be collected for each car choosing to run this series at each leg. This fee must be paid at the time of registration and is in addition to the host clubs entry fee.

Each division champion will be crowned Regional Rumble Champion and will receive a year-end award. **Guaranteed year-end awards for 1st thru 3rd place. Driver must run 4 of 5 legs to be eligible for year-end awards.**

Club with the highest cumulative points will be crowned Regional Rumble Champions and will receive a Regional Rumble Champion flag to fly above their track.
